J. L. Hesselhuus, Chairman of Ordinance Committee, presented the following:

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #42 ENTITLED "WATERWORKS SYSTEM" WHICH IS "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM, ESTABLISHING WATER RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION"

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CONRAD, GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA:

That Section 14 of said ordinance is hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

SECTION 14. Water rates shall be as follows: the first 1,500 gallons each quarter, \$1.50; the next 10,000 gallons at 60¢ per 1000 gallons; the next 10,000 gallons at 50¢ per 1000 gallons; the next 10,000 gallons at 30¢ per 1000 gallons; and all water used in excess of 31,500 gallons at the rate of 20¢ per 1000 gallons.

In case any user does not consume \$1.50 worth of water per quarter, he shall pay a minimum charge of \$1.50 per quarter.

This amendment shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

Moved by Hesselhuus and seconded by Gravenstein that the rules be suspended and the Amendment passed to its third reading.
