Three members from the Conrad Cooperative Board namely Robert Ralston, Stanley Grimes, and Paul Reece also Leslie Thayer from Consumers Cooperative Association, Kansas City, Mo. In regard to building or erecting an Anhydrous Amonia Plant in Conrad.

After much discussion it was decided to call a special meeting on Nov. 17, 1961 at 7:30at the Town Hall after more facts and data had been gathered.

A petition with thirty-one names was presented to the Council objecting to an Anhydrous Amonia P lant being located in the corporate limits of Conrad. Don Kliebenstein, legal advisor was present at this meeting.

John Hanzelka came before the Council for permission to put his curb stop in the alley between Vernon and Dwight steets ; then lay plastic pipe in sand and cover with sand to his property. Permission granted.

The clerk was authorized to get bids from painters here in town, Namely, Russie, Walling, and Fouch to paint the Town Hall outside, weather permitting. At least to paint the doors on the fire station and the remainder of the building to be completed in the spring.

Motion by Koehler , seconded by Wilson to have the Iowa Electric Light & power Co. to install light at the end of Circle Drive in Conrad Heights. Carried.
