She also presented the Council with a Plat of Conrad, Iowa consisting of a Series of Maps prepared by Woody King, showing Water, Sewer, Telephone, Gas, Storm Sewer, and Light Lines. The Mayor and Council very much appreciate the art in this fine piece of work. Councilmen Gallentine and Bunn will be responsible for hanging it. *Hazel Perry*

Metge moved that the Clerk write a letter of appreciation and Thank You to Woody King for a long and tedious task of preparing this Chart of Maps. Seconded by Rowlison. Carried.

Motion by Gallentine, second by Metge to extend to S.W. McAllister Clay & Felix Twp. Supervisor a Thank You for his efforts in getting the Resolution passed by the Board of Supervisors, setting up a program of County Assistance to towns amounting to 40 % of costs of permanent black top on streets leading into the towns of the County. This action will represent an approximate \$2400 assistance to Conrad on South Main Street. Carried.

Between thirty (30) and forty (40) cars were hauled to Roy Wilson Salvage Co. Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Russell Kruse made application for Building Permit for a 26x40 house Conrad Heights Addition.

Motion by Rowlison that a Bldg. Permit be issued for the above house according to specifications on file. A fee \$2.50 for the permit and \$50.00 for water service to the curb stop provided at town expense. Seconded by Bunn. Carried.

Motion by Rowlison to adjourn. Seconded by King. Carried.
