

August 28, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 8/28/00 in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanderson and the Pledge of Allegiance was said at 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Steve Mugge, and Lloyd Weber. Lisa Purvis arrived at 7:30 p.m., Robert Lutes was absent.

Motion by Weber, seconded by Callaway to approve an application for an outdoor service area for Bogie and Bacall's on September 2 & 3, 2000. Ayes 3.

Mugge motioned and Weber seconded to accept the Comet Trail Extension Project, establish completion, and approve the final pay request of \$4859.78. (resolution #114-8.00) Ayes: Weber, Callaway, Mugge. Nays: none.

Motion by Mugge, seconded by Weber to set a public hearing for September 25, 2000 at 7:30 p.m. to consider zoning changes for lots 1-5 at Sharp Acres Addition. Ayes 3.

Fred Leytham, Alliant Energy, presented council with new plans for the pole and installation package for the Main Street Lighting Project. Mugge moved to reject the bid from Acme Electric for the pole and installation for said project and to rebid the project for Main Street, and the West Bridge with no audio provisions. Ayes 3.


Gary Sindalar presented council with Maple ~~Street~~<sup>Avenue</sup> improvement cost estimates. Total estimated cost were \$225,000. The cost may be apportioned to each benefited property on the basis of lot frontage parallel to Maple Street and the respective properties behind the frontage property to a point halfway to the next parallel street. This assessment method is known as the Baltimore Standard and is the method that was used on the '87 Street Project.

Council reviewed assessment plats for the Duesenberg Drive Project. Estimated project cost is \$199,781, with \$94,184 of that total being assessable. Sindalar will present the assessment schedules to the cities Bond Attorney for review.

Sindalar also made recommendations for storm sewer issues and the curb and gutter on Main Street. Both were referred to committee for a later recommendation.

Weber motioned and Callaway seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m.
