Council met to consider any objection if any, as to the levies proposed, not being any, objections it was moved by Belz and second by Frederick that the entry record of the hearing and determination of the estimate.

Be it rememberd that on yhis ,the 12" day of Aug, 1924, the Council of the town of Conrad Grundy County, Iowa, met in session for the purpose of a hearing upon the budget estimate as filed with this board. there was present a quorum as required by law. thereupon the board investigated and found that the notice of the time and place of hearing had, accordang# to law and as directed by the board, been published on the 24" day of July 1924 in the Grundy Regster, a newspaper published at the County seat of said County, and on the 24" day of July 1924 in th^e Conrad Record a newspaper published in said Town, and that the affidavixs of publication thereof were on file with the County auditor. thereafter and on said day the estimate was taken up and considerd and taxpayers heard for and aganst saideestimate.

thereafter and after hearing all taxpayers desiring to be heard, the board took up the final consideration and after being fully advised the board determined that said estimate be corrected and completed so that when completed it should be in words and figures as stated herein. the Mayor and Clerk were thereupon directed to properly certify the estimate and forward the same to the county auditor.
