

Conrad, Iowa. August 10, 1915.

The Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad met in adjourned session from August 2, 1915, the meeting being called to order by Mayor S. F. Price.

The following councilmen answered present to roll call, F.L.Tansey, B. C. Wheeler, W.A.Kauffman, and John R.Gier. Absent I. S. Rourke.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

On motion the clerk was instructed to post the minutes of the meetings of the council on the door of the city hall until further notice.

On motion the clerk was instructed to write A.D.Woods relative to putting in a walk in front of his property.

Motion was made and carried that the matter of closing up the streets on Conrad Field Days, August 19 & 20 be left with the Mayor and the Chairman of the Street and Alley Comm.

Motion made and carried that the revenue from any concessions on Conrad Field Days Aug 19,20 be turned over to the Conrad Field Day Association.

On motion the clerk was instructed to write to the Leighto Supply Co. relative to town pump.

On Motion the following resolution was adopted;
Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa that the following tax levies be made in and for the Incorporated Town of Conrad for the ensuing year;

Incorporation Fund -----	10 Mills
Electric Light Fund -----	5 Mills
Water Fund -----	2 Mills
Bond Fund -----	7 Mills
Total -----	24 Mills
