#### RESOLUTION.

"WHEREAS, the Town of Conrad, Iowa, has requested the Central Iowa Telephone Company to have its operator upon receipt of a police or fire report put into operation the proper signal by means of signal apparatus placed within the reach of the operator duty; and

"WHEREAS, the Central Iowa Telephone Company has agreed to furnish the above described service without receiving any consideration therefore and only upon condition that it shall assume no liability to the Town of Conrad, Iowa, or to third persons in performing said service:

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa,

1. That the Central Iowa Telephone Company's operator act as the agent of said town in the performance of said service and not as a servant of the company.

2. That the Central Iowa Telephone Company assume no duty of performance whatsoever to said town or to any third person in connection with the performance of such service or in the installation or maintenance of the apparatus used in performing said service."
