

Council Met in special session, members answering to roll call Mayor Alexander, J R Gier, G S Beeman, H E Frederick, C C Belz, G R Gould. Moved by Belz and second by Gould, that we adopt the following Resolution. Be it Resolved by the Town Council of Conrad, that the rates for electric lights and power now prevailing in the Town of Conrad, are too high, and that the conditions at this time do not warrant the Iowa River Light and Power Company in changing such rates, and that they should be reduced to meet the changed conditions; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we are of the opinion that the rates in this Town should be as follows:

FOR LIGHTING:

For the first 25 K.W.H.-- 13 cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 25 K.W.H.-- 12 cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 25 K.W.H.-- 11cents per K.W.H.
 For all over 75 K.W.H.-- 10 cents per K.W.H.
 And the Minimum rate be -\$1.00 per Month.

FOR POWER

For the first 50 K.W.H.-- 9 cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 50 K.W.H.-- 8 cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 100 K.W.H.-- 7 cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 100 K.W.H.-- 6cents per K.W.H.
 For the next 300 K.W.H.

or over -- 5 cents per K.W.H.

And the Minimum charge --50 cents per horse power.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that H E Frederick is hereby appointed a member of a committee to consist of a representative from each municipality served by said Company, to meet with the Officers of the Company for the purpose of securing a reduction in said rates to the amounts specified above; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the said Committee can not make a satisfactory agreement with the Officers of the Company covering said rates, then the said member of the Committee is hereby instructed to prepare, or cause to be prepared, an Ordinance fixing the rates at the amounts above specified, to be presented to the Council at its next regular meeting.
