- 1, the Syate of Iowa should grant to each City and Town one-half of the Motor vehicle fees collected on the Morter vehicles of persons residi there for at least seven mounths of the year; or give an equal amount of relief based on some other plan,
- 2, the General Assembly should, therefore, approve only part of the program of the good roads Association which urges now that 1931 the annual excess of about \$10000000. be used entirely to carry out thier pay-as-you-go plan for the improvement of 1065 miles to be added to the present 7150- miles program.
