**LEGAL  
NOTICE**

**ORDINANCE No. 100**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING  
AUTHORITY TO REMOVE  
MOTOR VEHICLES FROM  
STREETS, ALLEYS OR HIGH-  
WAYS, WITHIN THE TOWN  
OF CONRAD, IOWA**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE  
COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
CONRAD, IOWA:**

**Section 1.**

That the Town Marshall, or any legally appointed deputy Marshall, or the superintendent of streets of the Town are hereby authorized to remove, or have removed, any motor vehicle or trailer from any street, public alley, or highway within the Town to any garage or other place under the following circumstances:

A. When a motor vehicle or trailer is upon a roadway and is so disabled as to constitute an obstruction to traffic and the persons or person in charge of the motor vehicle or trailer are for any reason physically incapacitated to such an extent as to be unable to provide for its custody or removal.

B. When any motor vehicle or trailer is left unattended upon a street or alley and is so illegally parked as to constitute a definite hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of traffic.

C. When any motor vehicle or trailer is left parked upon the same street or alley for a continuous period of 24 hours or more, provided that a diligent effort shall be first made to locate the owner and give him a reasonable opportunity to remove the same from the street.

D. When any motor vehicle or trailer is left parked upon a street, after the owner of such motor vehicle or trailer

has been notified by the town marshal, his deputy, or the superintendent of streets to temporarily move the same for purposes of snow removal or street cleaning.

E. When any motor vehicle or trailer is left parked upon any street or alley so as to interfere with snow removal or street cleaning, and the owner or person having custody thereof cannot be found by the exercise of reasonable diligence.

**Section 2.**

That the owner, or person having custody of any motor vehicle or trailer moved by the town under the provisions of this ordinance shall be required to pay to the town a reasonable charge for the towing and storage of such motor vehicle or trailer.

**Section 3.**

That the town marshal, his deputy, or the superintendent of streets shall notify the owner, or person having custody of any motor vehicle or trailer moved under the provisions of this ordinance of the fact of the moving of the same as soon as practical after said motor vehicle or trailer is moved.

**Section 4.**

That if any section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by any Court of competent or jurisdiction, the same shall not effect the validity of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.

**Section 5.**

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance

are hereby repealed.

**Section 6.**

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
