The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 06/23/02 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll were Shauna Callaway, Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, LeAnn Lynch, and Steve Mugge. Also present were Jane Katzer, Bob Hogle, Brad Murty, Pam Rider, Bob Mowen, Chad and Angus Callaway, Rick and Deb Mull, Rick and Mary Jones, and Bruce Marble. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council listened to a presentation from the Wolf Creed Child Care & Preschool Board of Directors. The Board gave council financial projections for the next couple of years and requested financial help from the City. Council agreed to place on the November ballot a 1% local option sales tax measure that would benefit the day care and preschool.

Rick and Mary Jones were present for an appeal hearing filed with them for keeping an illegal animal. The appeal determined that the no illegal animal existed and that it is common for people to have pet rats. Jones' presented papers proving the rats were purchased from a pet store. Council did request that the family keep the rats in the house at all times.

Gearhart motioned and Mugge seconded to approve a liquor license application for R.J.'s Lounge. Ayes 5.

Lutes motioned and Mugge seconded to pay the following claims: PCA - TIF rebate - \$12,152.50, Water deposit refunds - \$52.68, Stacy Simpson - CPR training - \$250.00. Ayes 5.

Council discussed the floor in the Fire Station office and agreed to allow them to replace it.

With no further business evident, council adjourned in a motion at 8:06 p.m.
