Conrad, Iowa. Oct. 10, 1916.

The Town Council met in special session with officials of the Iowa River Light and Power Co., to make some arrangements for a new contract for lighting the town.

Members present; S.F. Price (Mayor) J.R. Gier  
L.G. Sherbon, E.M. Stark, I.S. Rourke, and B.F. Wilhelm.

After discussing the advantages and disadvantages of the long and the short term contracts and other features of importance B.F. Wilhelm made a motion that a contract be made with the Iowa River Light and Power Co., for street lighting service for a period to extend to April 30, 1925. on their agreeing to pay \$330.00 in lieu of city claim of ownership to poles and lighting equipment. Contract to be prepared by company and lighting committee and submitted to the council for approval. Seconded by L.G. Sherbon.
