for a 5 year term to the Planning Commission and Bud Shaw as a new
member as H.D. Carnes declined another term. Second by Beeghly. Carried.

A new city map is being formulated by Clapsaddle- Garber Associates
to include the additions of Oakview, Oakwood, Cedarcrest and Athletic
Grounds of Conrad School.

A letter from Grundy County Concerned Taxpayers Assoc. was read
requesting no raise in the millage for Conrad and to comply with the
wage freeze.

A letter from Ritchie Mfg. Co by C.D. Wilson Jr. requested that one-
half block be zoned as commercial. This was referred to the Plan
Commission.

Motion by Graham to hire Bill Hartwig for Police duty 5 nites per
week at \$548.00 per month and 3 weeks paid vacation. Second by McLean
Carried. Hartwig responsible xxxxxxxxxx to obtain relief
police duty.
