Whereas, a petition was presented to the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, which appears in words and figures as follows:-

"To the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa The undersigned qualified electors of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, hereby petition your honorable body to call an election of the qualified voters of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, at which shall be submitted the question of extension of the water mains in said town and the question of authorizing said council to contract indebtedness for such purpose and issuing bonds of said town for such purpose not exceeding \$13000. and levying an annual tax upon the taxable property of said town for the purpose of paying said bonds"

And, Whereas upon proper and careful inspection it appears that said petition was signed by more than twenty-five per cent of the number voting at the last regular municipal election;

Now Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, that there shall be submitted to the voters of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa at the regular municipal election to be held in said town on the following proposition:-
