The Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment from its February 6, 1950 meeting and pursuant to notice on all of the individual council members, at the Town Hall in Conrad, Iowa, at 7 o'clock P.M. on February 20, 1950 with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the roll being called there were present the following - Mayor Gravenstein, Clerk H.D. Hunt and Councilmen Howard Burch, Don Clinite, Jim Gould, Don Martin, Walter Neuroth. Absent None.

The Council thereupon proceeded with its regular business and Councilman Burch introduced and read the resolution next hereinafter set out and moved its adoption, seconded by Councilman Clinite and after due consideration thereof by the Council, the Mayor put the question upon the adoption of said resolution, and the roll being called, the following voted:

Ayes: Burch, Clinite, Gould, Martin, Neuroth. Nays None.

Whereupon the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as follows,

towit:- RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS AT THE REGULAR ELECTION TO BE HELD MARCH 27, 1950, THE QUESTION OF EXTENDING THE WATER MAINS OF SAID TOWN AND AUTHORIZING SAID COUNCIL TO CONTRACT INDEBTEDNESS THEREFOR AND ISSUE BONDS THEREFOR AND LEVY ANNUAL TAXES TO PAY SAID BONDS.

Whereas, a petition was presented to the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, which appears in words and figures as follows:-

"To the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa The undersigned qualified electors of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, hereby petition your honorable body to call an election of the qualified voters of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, at which shall be submitted the question of extension of the water mains in said town and the question of authorizing said council to contract indebtedness for such purpose and issuing bonds of said town for such purpose not exceeding \$13000. and levying an annual tax upon the taxable property of said town for the purpose of paying said bonds"

And, Whereas upon proper and careful inspection it appears that said petition was signed by more than twenty-five per cent of the number voting at the last regular municipal election;

Now Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, that there shall be submitted to the voters of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa at the regular municipal election to be held in said town on March 27, 1950 the following proposition:-

"Shall the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa extend its water mains and contract indebtedness for such purpose not exceeding \$13000. and issue bonds for such purpose not exceeding \$13000. and levy tax annually upon the taxable property in the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, not exceeding seven mills per annum for the payment of such bonds and the interest thereon?"

Passed and approved this 20th day of February A.D. 1950 Moved by Martin seconded by Gould that council adjourn. carried
