

paid out of the general fund of the Town or out of the sewer fund as provided in Section 831 of the Code of Iowa or as provided in subdivision three of Section 894 of the Code as may be determined by the Town Council of said Town and the town may, if it so elects, pay the cost of said sewer at the intersection of the streets, highways, avenues and alleys, or any part of it, and one-half of the cost of the same at spaces opposite property, by the town of Conrad, or any part thereof, from the city sewer fund, or the district sewer fund, or from the general revenue of said town?

The contractor shall look exclusively to the funds stated in the contract for payment for said sewer, sewer outlet and disposal plant and the town of Conrad will not make itself pecuniarily liable for the payment of the cost of any part of said improvement and will not incur any indebtedness for the same, except the issuance of the bonds above referred to.

The contractor shall give good and sufficient bond to be approved by the town council obligating the contractor and his bondsmen to a faithful performance of the contract and to keep the said street improvement in good repair for a period of one year after the acceptance of the same by said town.

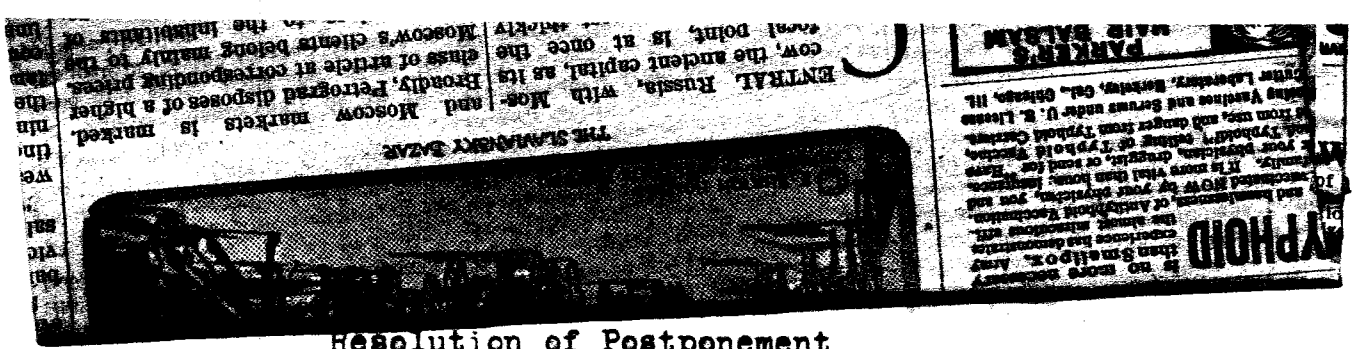

Resolution of Postponement

Be it resolved by the Town Council of the To Incorporated Town of Corad, Iowa that consideration for passage of the resolution of Necessity providing for the construction of a sewer system on the following streets, parts of streets and street and alley intersections, to-wit;- On Washington Street, Center Street to Alba Street; on Main Street Walnut Street to Alba Street, on Center Street, Washington Street to Main Street, on Church Street, Walnut Street to Lillian Avenue; on Vernon Street, Center Street to Lillian Avenue on Dwight Street, Center Street to Lillian Avenue, on Alice street, Center Street to Lillian Avenue; on Center Street yernon Street; to Alice Street; on Jennings Street, Walnut Street to Center Street, on Walnut Street, Main Street to east end of Walnut Street, on Jennings Street, Walnut Street to 375 feet south of the south line of Walnut Street, introduced this 2nd day of July A.D. 1917 be and the same is hereby postponed to the 27th day of July A.D. 1917 at seven o'clock P.M. and the Town Clerk is hereby directed to cause notice thereof to be given as by law provided.
