START THE NEW YEAR HERE:

Time of meeting

April 3, 1950

Immediately after the old council adjourned, Mayor Gravenstein who was re-elected mayor for another term of two years called the new council together, with the following members present.

Burch, H.L. B.E.Bone, H.D.Martin, D.C.Reece. Absent Walter Neuroth.

Mayor Gravenstein than gave the oath of office to the new councilmen.

Moved by Martin seconded by Burch that H.D.Hunt be appointed Town Clerk at his present salary of \$400.00 per year. This amount to be paid in four quarterly payments. Carried.

Mayor Gravenstein appointed Dr.R.T.Spain to serve as Health Physician for the ensuing two years.

Moved by Martin seconded by Bone that the salary of Dr.R.T.Spain be set at \$20.00 per year, payable annually. Carried.

Mayor Gravenstein appointed Marion W. Leonard as Town Marshall for the ensuing two years.

Moved by Burch seconded by Martin that the compensation of the Town Marshall and Night Watch for the ensuing term be set at \$180.00 per month, payable monthly, said compenhsion to include the care of the Fire Truck. Carried.

Mayor Gravenstein appointed R.C.Dickover as street commissioner for the ensuing two years. Moved by Burch seconded by Martin that the street commissioner compensation be set at \$185.00 per month, \$40.00 of this amount to be paid from the water fund, taking care of the town pump and the reading of the water meters. Carried.

Moved by Burch seconded by Martin that the bonds of Ray Gravenstein, #52268, Evelyn Stevens, #45454, and H.D.Hunt, #40991 be approved and accepted. Carried.

Mayor Gravenstein appointed Mr.H.A.Willoughby of Grundy Center, solicitor of the Incorporated Town of Conrad for the next two years. Carried. Moved by Martin seconded by Burch that the Water Tower Paint and Repair Company of Clear Lake, Iowa be instructed to start painting the water tower. Carried.

Councilman Burch introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Bone.

Resolution Naming Depository of Public Funds.

BE IT RESOLVED, BY the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa:

That we do hereby designate the following named bank to be the depository of the town funds in the amounts not to exceed the amount named opposite said designated depository and the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to deposit the town funds in amounts not to exceed in the aggregate the amounts named for said bank as follows, to-wit:

First State Bank, Conrad, Iowa: 20000.00
Maximum Deposit under this Resolution; \$10,000.00

On call of roll, Councilmen Bone, Burch, Martin, and Reece all voted 'aye'. Nays; None. Mayor Gravenstein than declared this Resolution duly passed and adopted this 3rd day of April A.D., 1950.
