The City Council met in adjourned meeting at seven o'clock P.M. from the meeting of September 11th. The following members answered present to the call of the roll; Mayor S.F.Price, John R.Gier, Levi G.Sherbon, B.F.Wilhelm, I.S.Rourke, E.M.Stark. Visitors present D.L.Bockes.

The minutes of meeting of September 11th were read and approved with the following correction; That the word regular be inserted before the word meeting in the motion, " That the resignation of H.E.Frederick be laid on the table until the next meeting."

This meeting being called primarily to hear the report of the work of Engineer T.R.Perry, Mr.Perry at this time came to the council chamber and with the council went over his work so far, relative to covering the city with a sanitary sewerage system. Mr.Perry reported that the outlet for a disposal plant would have to be to the south and east and the city could be covered with a system that would not cost above the average system in other cities of this size and class.

The matter of preliminary legal details discussed and on motion by John R.Gier seconded by I.S.Rourke that this meeting adjourn until September 13th 16 at one o'clock P.M. at the Conrad State Bank's directors room. Carried.

The Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad met in adjourned session from September 12, 1916. The meeting was called to order by the Hon. Mayor S.F. Price.

Moved by E.M. Stark seconded by Levi G. Sherbon that the council accept the resignation of H.E. Frederick as Town Clerk. Carried.

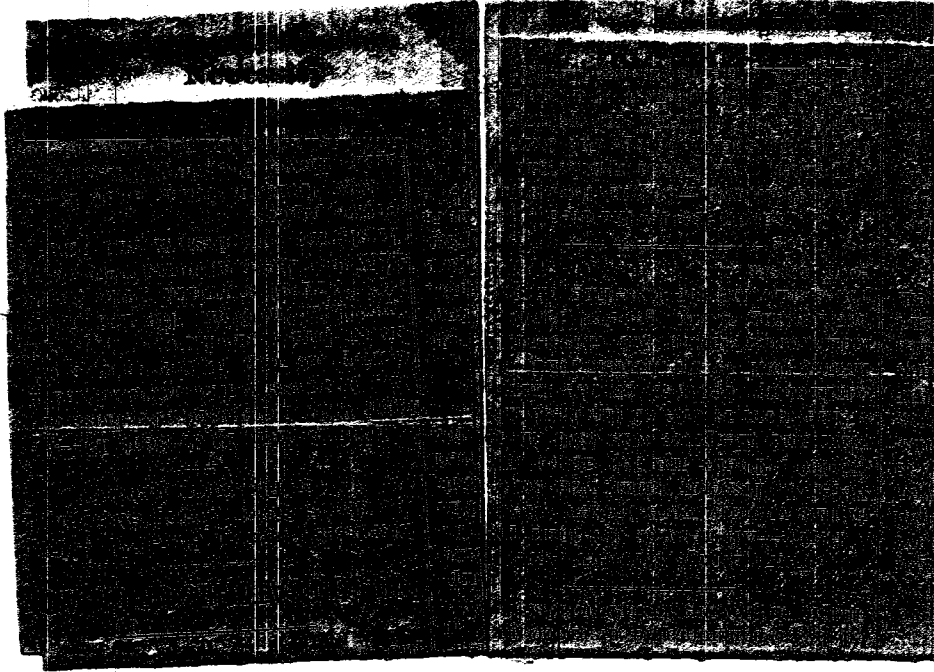
Moved by I.S. Rourke seconded by Levi G. Sherbon that the Council elect J.R. Witzigman Town Clerk. Carried.

J.R. Witzigman was sworn in as Town Clerk at this time by the Mayor.

Councilman John R. Gier introduced the following resolution and moved that consideration of the same be postponed to Oct. 6, 1916. and that the clerk be instructed to publish notice of the hearing upon said resolutions as by law required. Motion seconded by Councilman L.G. Sherbon? Roll was ordered called and resulted as follows;
