

The Conrad City Council met in special session on 03-23-23. Officials present via phone were Council Members Todd Schnathorst, John Dinsmore, Jeff Frank, Lindsay Kuhl and Peg Brown. Lori Stansberry was also in attendance. Mayor Martin called the meeting to order at 12:01 pm.

Schnathorst made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-12 setting April 26, 2023 at noon for the public hearing on the Budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2024. Frank seconded the motion. Resolution approved 5-0.

Schnathorst made a motion and was seconded by Brown to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 12:05 pm.
