The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 03/28/05 at the Conrad Municipal Building. Answering roll call was Jim Barger, Shauna Callaway, Bill Gearhart, LeAnn Lynch, and Al Stewart. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council discussed the purchase of a new B-CERT Rescue Unit as considered at the last meeting. Gearhart motioned to purchase the 2004 Osage Type III Ambulance on a Ford E-450 cutaway chassis with up to \$84,500 of Catherine Farmer Estate money and the balance to be paid from B-CERT Association donations. Any future donations, rebates, or allocations specified to be applied towards the rescue unit shall be deposited back into the Catherine Farmer Estate fund. Barger seconded the motion and roll was as follows. Ayes – Gearhart, Callaway, Stewart, Barger, Lynch.

A city wide clean up day was discussed by council. Barger motioned and Callaway seconded to run an ad in The Record to survey citizens as to whether they would support a clean up day. Motion carried.

Barger motioned and Gearhart seconded to contract with Jerico Services for two applications of dust control on 330<sup>th</sup> Street, and two alleys. Motion carried.

With no further business evident, council adjourned at 7:45 PM.
