Fire Department & BCERT members, Tom Schultz, Stacey Hines, Jordan Hoy, Grant Benson, and Krista Grant, were present to announce they had received a \$50,000 grant from the Alexander Trust to be used towards equipping the future new fire station. Council commended the department for their efforts.

Council member Callaway moved, second by Schnathorst, to approve the construction of a sprinkler system at Ritchie Industries as presented by Denny McLean. This pump, sized for demands created by extra hazard group 2, will pull the city water supply down to 7 to 10 psi. Ayes: 3.

Council member Stattler moved, second by Schnathorst, to enter into an engineering agreement with Ryken Engineering for a storm water study. The study will evaluate the existing storm water system and locate potential areas of expansion. The contract is not to exceed \$15,000 and will be completed by November 14, 2013. Ayes: 3.

Council member Callaway moved, second by Stattler, to enter into contract with S.L. Baumeier Co, 1252 Hwy 96, Gladbrook, Iowa, in the amount of \$30,600 for the clearing and clean-up of the "Hartwig" land located east of city limits recently purchased by the City. Ayes: 3.

Council member Callaway moved, second by Stattler to adopt resolution #2013-08.9 approving the annual street finance report. Ayes: Stattler, Callaway, Schnathorst. Nays: none.

Council member Schnathorst moved, second by Callaway, to enter into a memorandum of understanding with Grundy County Public Health for the Community Transformation Project grant in the amount of \$5,000 for curb cut replacement. Ayes: 3.

Council discussed the invitation to become a member of the Grundy County Development Alliance, with dues of \$2.80 per capita. Council decided not to enter into the consortium at this time.

Council acknowledged a press release from Grundy County Assessor, John Freese, about a door-to-door inspection of all Grundy County properties.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.
