The Conrad City Council met in special session on 09/26/13 at the Conrad City Hall. Officials present were Council Members Peg Brown, Ryan Callaway, Brad Murty, and Todd Schnathorst. Absent: Gary Stattler. Mayor Jeff Martin called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The agenda was approved as presented.

Council expressed their concern about the financial condition of Wolf Creek Childcare. Council member Murty recommended that a committee of community leaders be appointed to look at the structure of the daycare, options to improve the financial status, and a plan to implement changes. Council agreed to table the request for additional funds from the daycare for water prevention measures at this time and suggested that the daycare board consider this expense in their FY 2015 budget.

Council member Schnathorst moved, second by Brown, to enter into an engineering agreement with Ryken Engineering for a site survey of the Hartwig land recently purchased by the city. Ayes: 4.

After discussion, Council member Murty moved to begin proceedings to transfer a portion of the recently purchased Hartwig land to the Community Development Corporation for development. Callaway seconded. Ayes: 4.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned at 7:24 PM.
