The Conrad City Council met in a special budget work session on 01-23-19 in the Council Chambers. Officials present were Council Members John Dinsmore, Todd Schnathorst, Brad Murty, Peg Brown and Diane Miller. Also in attendance: Lori Stansberry, City Administrator/Clerk; Bruce Marble and Nick Kitzman, Public Works; and Lee Gallentine, Clapsaddle Garber Associates.
